ADL	Anti-Defamation League	Jewish organization that tracks and monitors hate and antisemitism domestically and internationally.
AEL	Authorized Equipment List	This list contains the allowable equipment in Sections 14 and 15 that an applicant can apply for under the NSGP.
CISA	Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency	A DHS agency that provides resources and tools on security topics
DHS	Department of Homeland Security	DHS/FEMA allocate the NSGP funds
EHP	Environmental & Historic Preservation Form	A FEMA form that is required to be completed by all NSGP awardees to assess environmental impact.
EIN	Employer Identification Number	Federal tax identification number for organizations
FEMA	Federal Emergency Management Agency	Agency that oversees and administers the NSGP.
IJ	Investment Justification	The NSGP application
JFNA	The Jewish Federations of North America	JFNA represents nearly 146 Federations and nearly 400 independent Jewish communities across North America.
NOFO	Notice of Funding Opportunity	This document contains the guidelines and funding levels for the annual NSGP allocation.
NSGP	Nonprofit Security Grant Program	FEMA's grant program for nonprofit organizations to obtain funds for target hardening
NSGP – S	NSGP-State	Areas that are outside of the NSGP-UA designated areas
NSGP – UA	NSGP-Urban Area	Areas designated by FEMA as high-risk urban areas
SAA	State Administrative Agency	The SAA is the only eligible applicant to apply for NSGP funding to FEMA. The SAA is the nonprofit organization's point of contact for the NSGP application. For a list of SAA points of contact, <a href="#">click here</a> .
SAM.gov	System for Award Management	To obtain a UEI or obtain active SAM status, go to <a href="http://www.SAM.gov">www.SAM.gov</a> .
TVRA	Threat, Vulnerability, and Risk Assessment	The TVRA is a security assessment that identifies the vulnerabilities of a physical site.
UEI	Unique Entity Identifier	Every organization must have its own UEI number so that it can easily be identified within the federal system.
